

Daily Health Screening for Students and Drivers

We have updated our process so that you do not have to fill out a form on a weekly basis. Instead, we ask that every parent of Hope Christian Preschool student[s] should go through the following checklist each morning before leaving for in-person instruction. Please answer these questions keeping in mind **the students, any drivers, as well as siblings that may enter the building.**

Children that become ill during the school day with symptoms from the health screen form will need to be picked up and have a doctor's note to return to school.

Please keep track of your child's daily drivers in case it becomes necessary for contact tracing in the event the Health Department requests this information.

SELF-SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE

By having your child attend school, you are confirming that your child and others entering the building with them can successfully complete this health questionnaire.

- Temperature 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for individuals with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- Had close contact within the last 14 days (within six feet) with a person with confirmed case of COVID-19
- Had close contact within the last 14 days (within six feet) with a person currently under quarantine for possible exposure.
- Traveled to a state currently on NYS restricted list

If you checked any of the above boxes, your child should stay home.

When in doubt, or if your child is showing persistent flu-like or cold symptoms, please keep your child home and consult your personal physician.

We thank you for your family's sacrifice and commitment to keep our HCPS community healthy and open.

Sending a student to school who has exhibited COVID-19 symptoms in the last 24 hours places other students and staff at risk of becoming ill. It also increases the likelihood that schools will have to temporarily close.
