3. What are some of the convincing proofs of Jesus' resurrection that would make sense to your non-believing friends?
4. Why is it important to have the Holy Spirit's power in our life? In what ways do you see His power manifest in your life?
5. Why is Jesus ascension so important?

6. You are called to be a witness. What is your “Jerusalem” where you are called to?

7. Jesus promised to come back. How does that truth impact the way you live now?
