2. Why did God wait until Pentecost (a celebrative harvest festival of first fruits) to give the Holy Spirit?
3. Why is it significant that there was wind and fire with the coming of the Holy Spirit?
(See 1 Kings 19:11-13; Genesis 15: 17-18; Job 38:1)
4. How does being filled with the Holy Spirit relate to bearing witness to Jesus?
5. If you had been there, would you have been amazed, perplexed or would you have made fun of the disciples?
