3. Paul's life was full of hardship but he was full of joy (see Philippians 1:18). How is this possible?
4. Do you believe you have ever experienced this type of joy especially under tough circumstances? If no, what kept you from experiencing this joy?

5. Given what you learned about this joy what might you do different in your daily life?
