Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9

- “Love the Lord, your God.” How did He become “your” God? How does gracious call upon our lives impact the way we parent our children?
- We are to talk about our God in the morning and in the evening, when we are at home and when we are away. How can events (covid, a car accident, a sunrise) be talking points with our children about our God?

- What Bible verse is really important to you? What would you say to your children about the verse's impact upon your life?
