2. What do you think this letter means to the church today?

5. The Gospel is not just good news when everything is going right, but it is good news when the bottom falls out on our lives. How can you share the Gospel through words and actions when you are going through tough times?

6. PK mentioned Polycarp, the Bishop of Smyrna and his martyrdom. What have you sacrificed or set aside; how have you lived your life incongruent with culture to follow Christ?
