1. What was the crowd hoping for when Jesus rode into Jerusalem?

2. Pastor Kirk talked about Pilate's entrance (6,000 soldiers from the west) and Jesus' entrance from the east. Why do we have a hard time living our lives in humility and servanthood? What are the blessings that come if we follow Jesus' way?

3. Jesus tells two of His disciples to get a colt (v. 33-34). What is strange about this request? What does it show us about obedience?

4. What does it mean to you that Jesus is King?

5. Pastor Kirk mentioned three things that show Jesus is our King - how we worship, how we obey, and our expectations of Jesus. Explain how those three things show Jesus' rule in your life.

6. What areas of life do you need to submit more to Jesus your King?
