## **Lesson Eleven**

### **Revelation 18-19**

#### **Revelation 18:1-3**

- **Another angel – from heaven – great authority – bright with his glory.**
- **Babylon has fallen – Isaiah 21:9; Jeremiah 51:37.**
- **Two groups are mentioned – political rulers and merchants.**

#### **Revelation 18:4-8**

- **Another voice – is it God? Is it Jesus?**
- **Come out from her – Isaiah 48:20; Jeremiah 51:45.**
- **Her sins heaped as high as the heavens – Genesis 18:20-21.**
- **The judgment upon Babylon.**

#### **Revelation 18:9-20**

- **Kings, merchants, sailors mourn over the great city's judgment.**
- **The significance of a “single hour.”**
- **The saints respond – rejoice.**

#### **Revelation 18:21-24**

- **The death knell – no more.**

#### **Revelation 19:1-5**

- **Five (maybe six) hallelujahs – heaven's great Hallelujah Chorus.**

### **Revelation 19:6-8**

- The roar of many waters – also in 1:15 and 14:2.
- “Reigns” – a completed action.
- The concept of Divine marriage deeply rooted in the Old Testament.
- The New Testament pictures it more like an engagement with the wedding still in the future.
- In New Testament times the groom’s father often paid the betrothal price.
- It was “granted” her.

### **Revelation 19:9-10**

- The 4<sup>th</sup> beatitude.
- “These are the true words of God.”
- John bows down to an angel?

### **Revelation 19:11-16**

- Rider on a white horse.
- Four names
  - Faithful and True
  - The unknown name.
  - The Word of God.
  - King of kings and Lord of lords.

### **Revelation 19:17-21**

- The burial of evil – the funeral you won’t mind attending.
