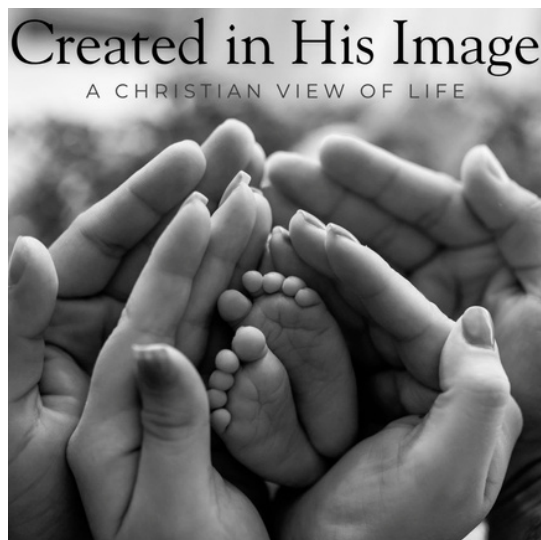
SOUND HEARTS FOR SOUND MINDS

CREATED IN HIS IMAGE

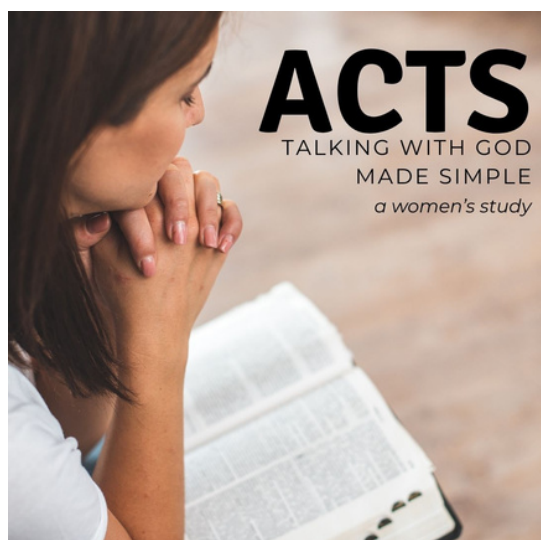

ACTS: TALKING WITH GOD MADE SIMPLE *for women*

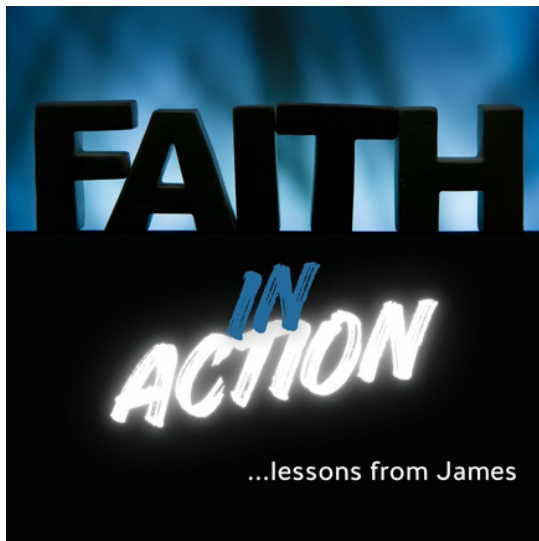

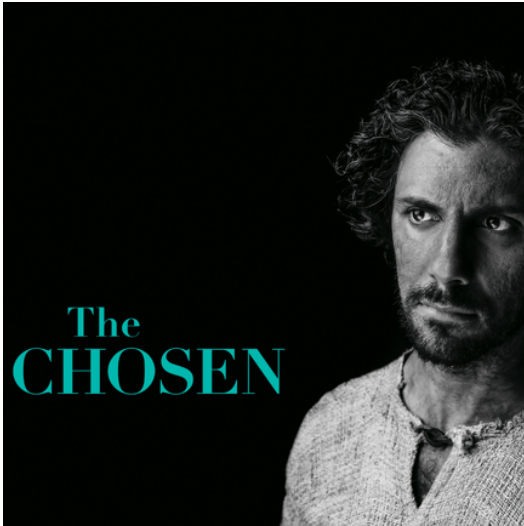
FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY **David & Marianne Virgilio**

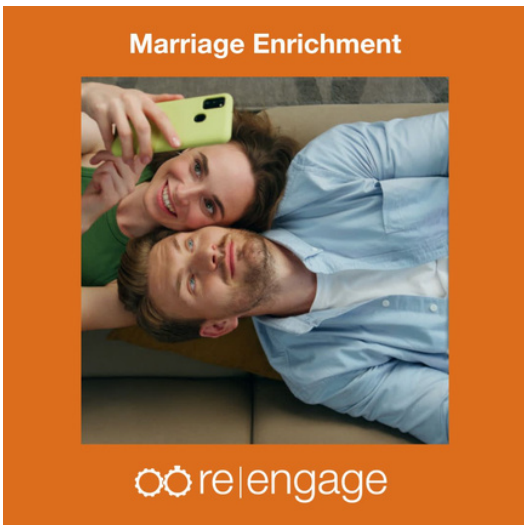
MERGE

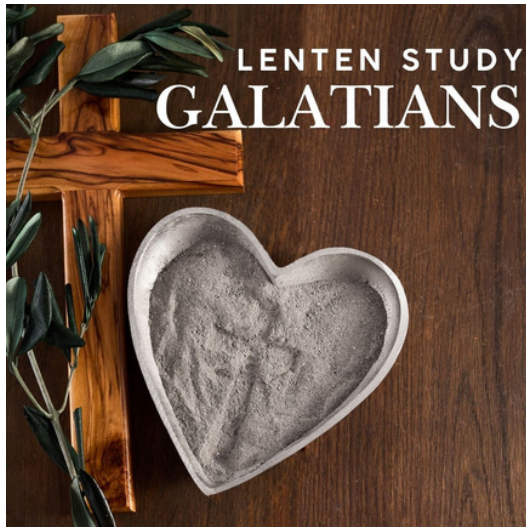
DISCOVER THE 5G'S

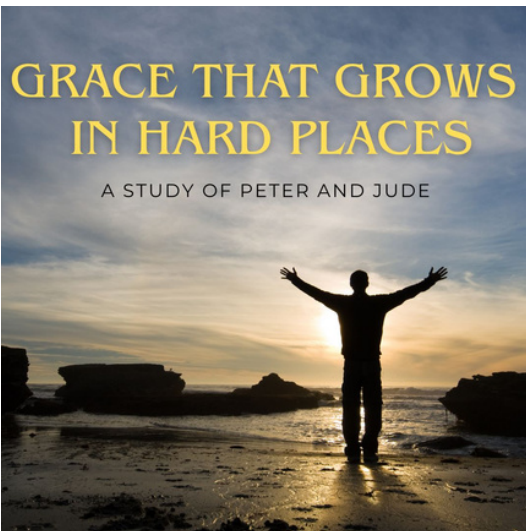
THE PATRIARCHS: ORDINARY MEN IN GOD'S EXTRAORDINARY PLAN

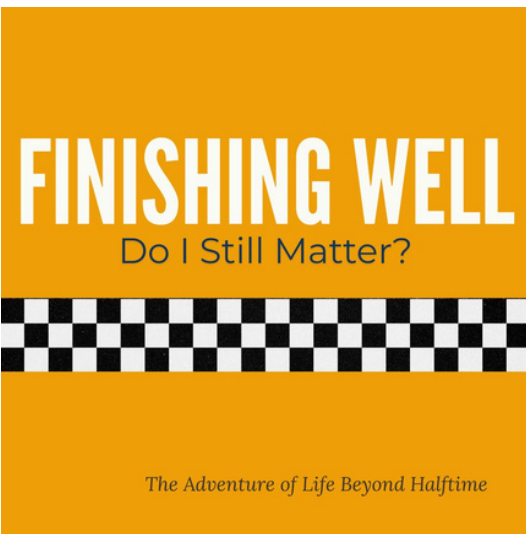


GRACE THAT GROWS IN HARD PLACES: **A Study of Peter and Jude** **Kristo Miettinen**

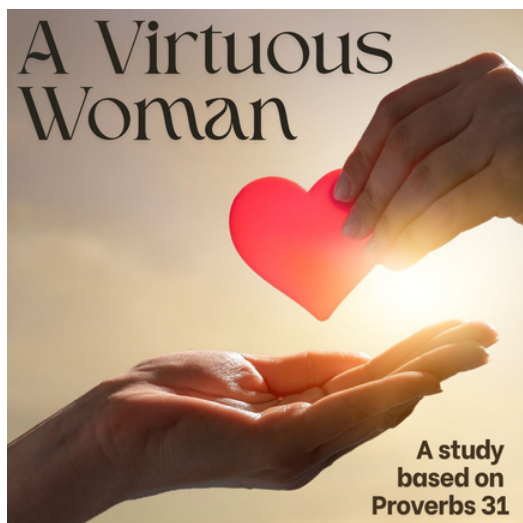

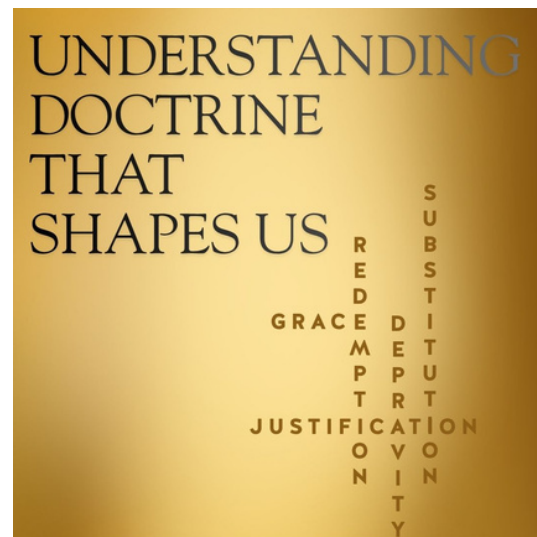
God's Plan for All People

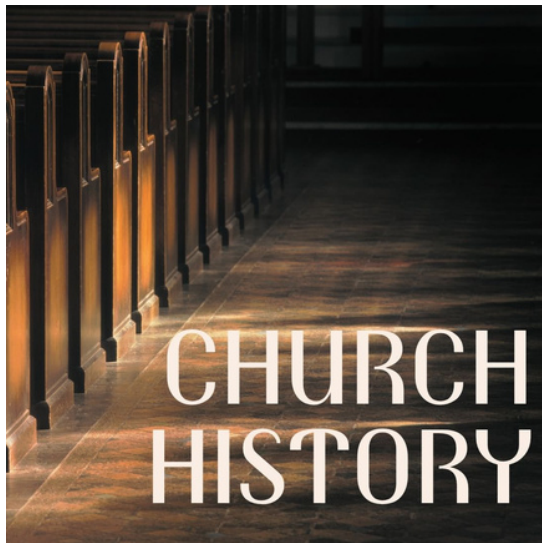
UNDERSTANDING DOCTRINE THAT SHAPES US

CHURCH HISTORY

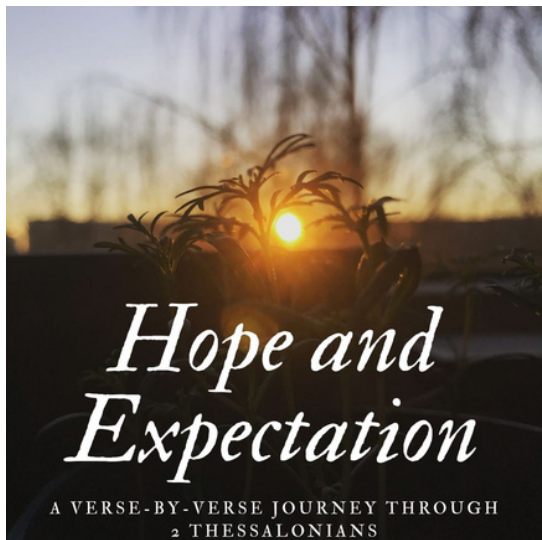
